

Grassland, Savannah, Rangeland in Climate Context

- Ensure the protection, sustainable management and restoration of natural GSRs in adaptation plans and Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs)
- Protect natural GSRs from land use changes such as inappropriate afforestation and agricultural intensification, which lead to net losses of carbon stocks, biodiversity and other ecosystem services
- Align UNFCCC actions on GSRs with the CBD and UNCCD, including through National Biodiversity Strategies and Action Plans (NBSAPs) and Land Degradation Neutrality (LDN) targets.




Grassland, Savannah Rangelands in NDCs

- **Pakistan** in its updated NDC states its plans to implement its ecosystem restoration initiative that sets specific ecosystem rehabilitation goals, including the restoration of 6% of degraded grassland.
- Argentina emphasizes and promotes the conservation, restoration and sustainable management of ecosystems, especially native forests, wetlands, peatlands, and natural grasslands as ecosystems that significantly con-tribute to carbon absorption and storage.
- EU: The updated NDC contains a sectoral target for the land use and land use change and forestry as well as wetland and grassland considerations.

FAST Initiative:

The Egyptian COP27 presidency and more than 20 agriculture ministers launched the Food and Agriculture for Sustainable Transformation (FAST) initiative, which is a multi-stakeholder programme that aims to impact finance, adaptation efforts and pursue the Paris Agreement's 1.5°C limit.

Introduced by <u>Champions 12.3</u>, a coalition of executives across various organizations, the **'123 Pledge'** to accelerate action to reduce food loss and waste worldwide.



Drought Resilience Alliance.

The Alliance will be bolstered by new political commitments, including a Euro 5 million seed fund announced by Spain. The Alliance calls on leaders to make drought resilience a priority in national development and cooperation, including deepening the engagement of stakeholders, such as the private sector, in work on drought resilience.
