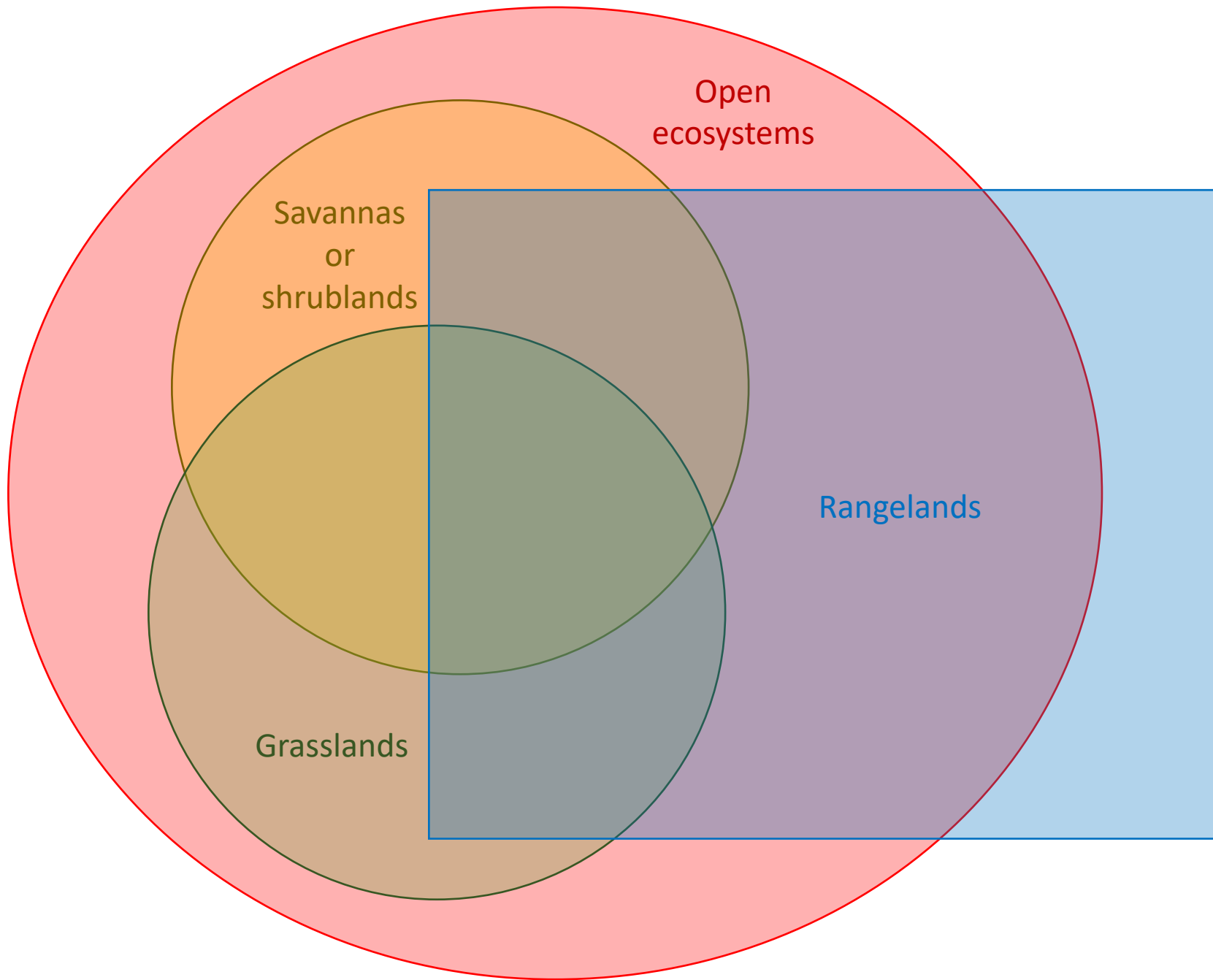

(Including Open Ecosystems and Shrublands)

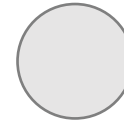

Anthropogenic habitat



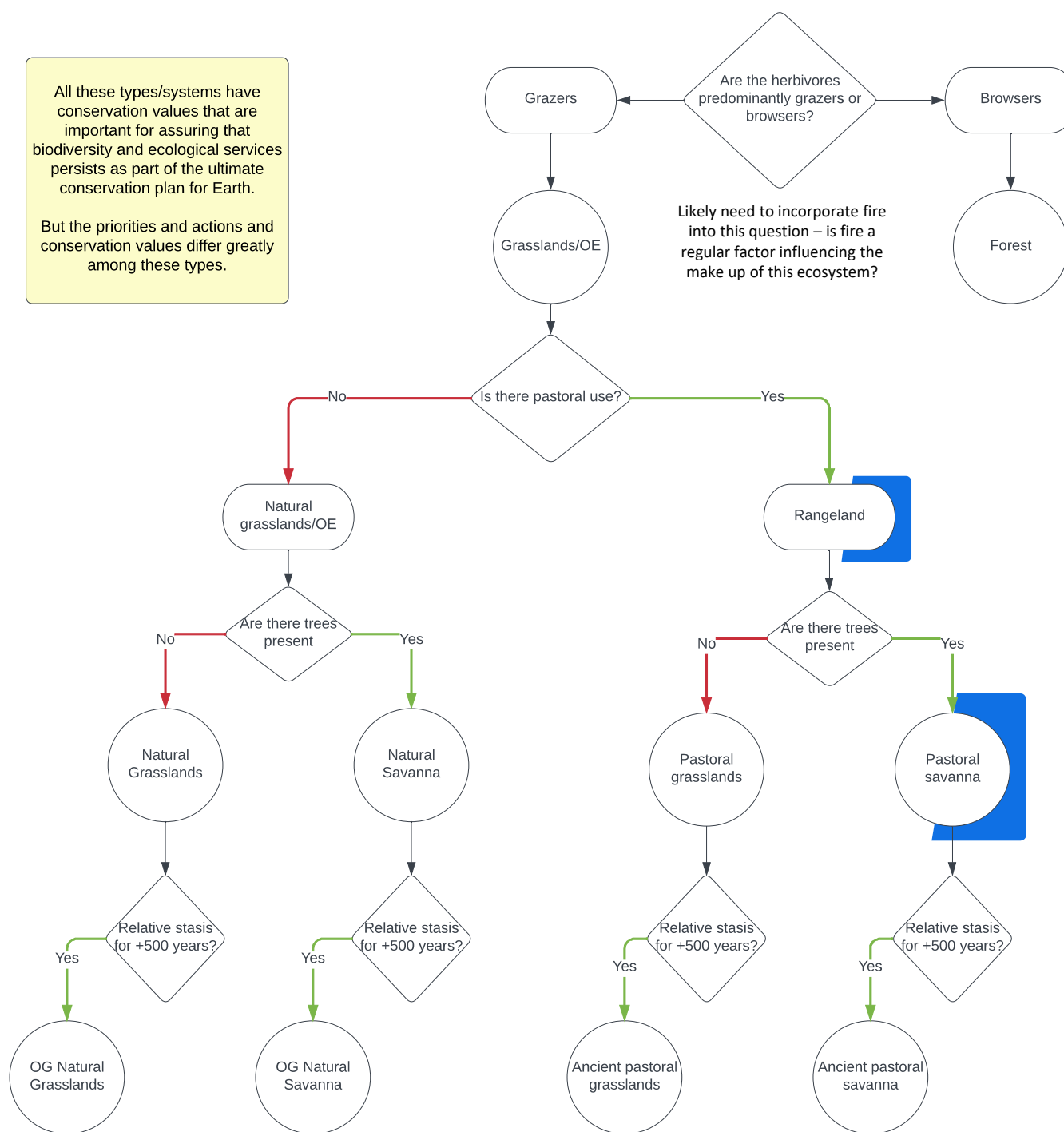

All these types/systems have conservation values that are important for assuring that biodiversity and ecological services persists as part of the ultimate conservation plan for Earth.

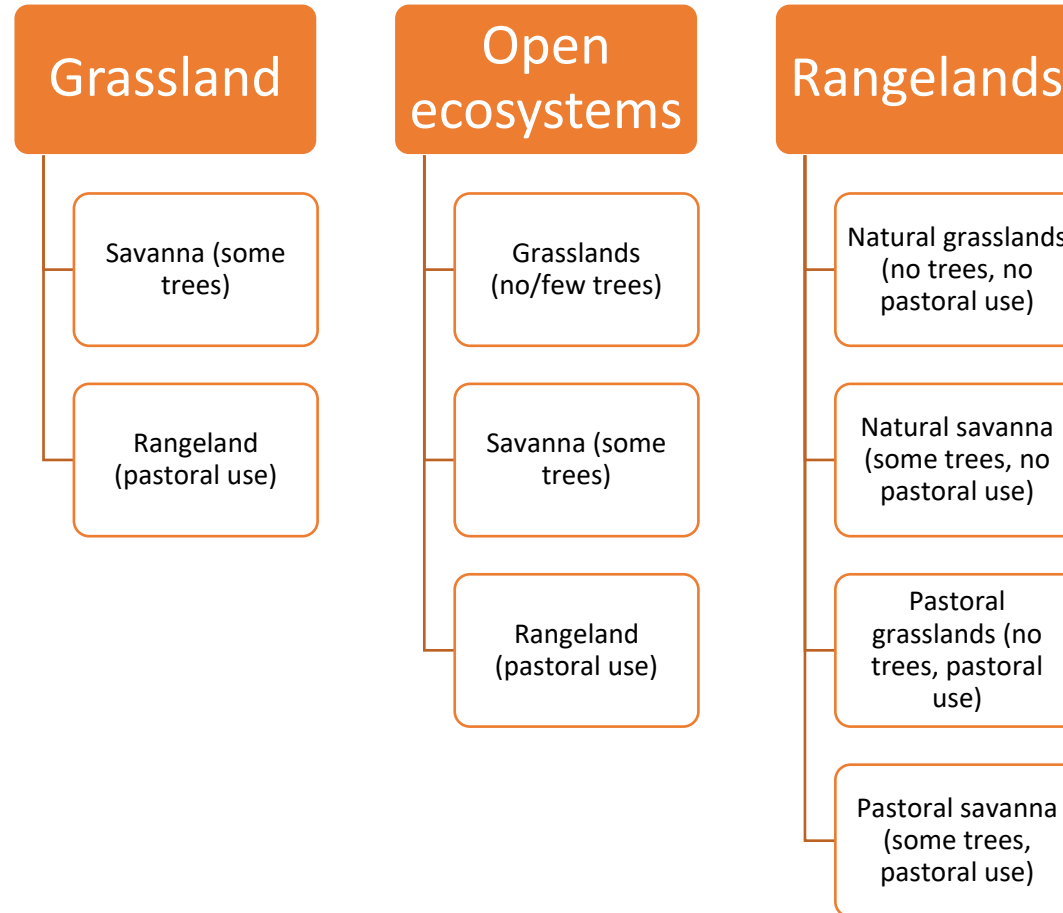
But the priorities and actions and conservation values differ greatly among these types.
